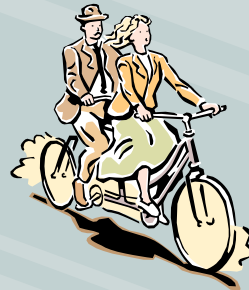

What is the “Tour de France”?

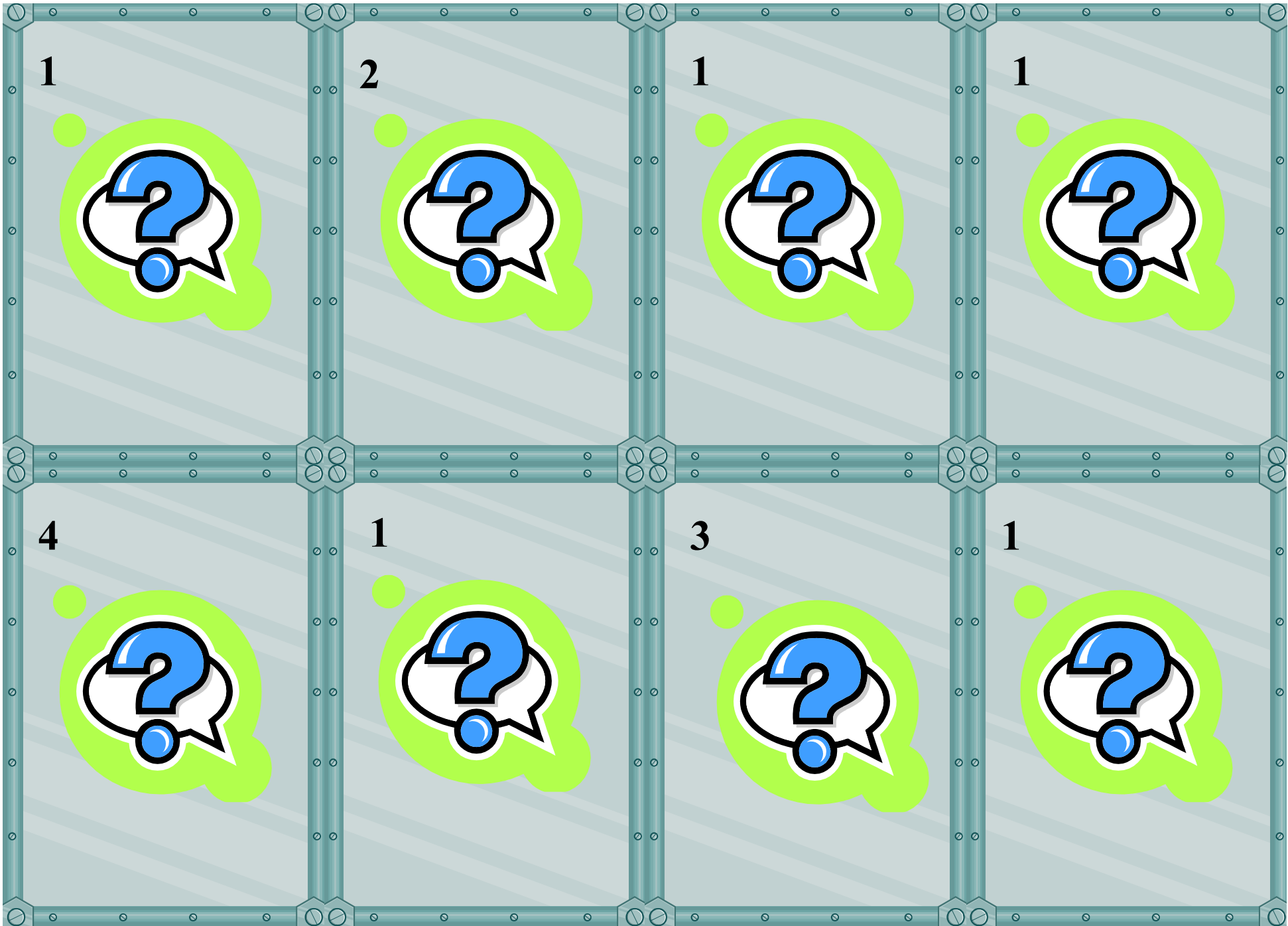


Answer: The Tour de France is a bicycle race over more than 3,500 kilometres. It usually lasts 23 days.

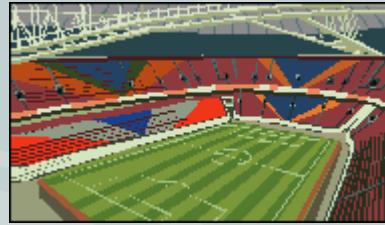
Answer: It is a type of food, from the Alps region, made mainly with a lot of cheese, bacon and potatoes. We eat it during winter, especially when we go skiing!

What is the "Stade de France" and where is it?



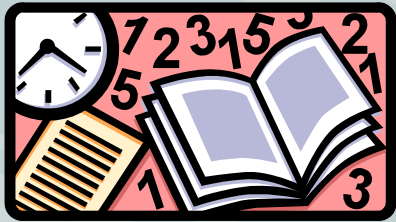
Answer: It is the national stadium of France, it is situated in the suburb of Paris
